

COVID-19 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES IN-PERSON AND DISTANCE LEARNING

School of Photography Darkroom use protocol

PREMISE

The large size of the darkroom means that it can be used by up to three people, a lecturer and 2 students. The darkroom may be used if the following protocol is respected. Each work session inside the darkroom cannot last longer 40/45 minutes.

SCHOOL OF PHOTOGRAPHY DARK ROOM USE PROTOCOL

Before entering the darkroom every single person must:

- wear two surgical masks or a surgical mask on their face and a FFP2 mask over it;
- wear two pairs of disposable gloves making sure to leave the edge of the external one in a position that facilitates taking it off afterwards;
- sanitize his/her hands after wearing the gloves.

Before leaving the darkroom every single person must:

- sanitize his/her hands without taking the gloves off;
- remove the external mask and through it in a sealed trash can;
- remove the external gloves and throw them in a sealed trash can;
- keep the surgical mask on and the inner pair of gloves.

During the work session, as well as after it, it is mandatory to air out the space.

It should also be noted that the use of the darkroom and its protocol, like the other protocols such as the one related to the filming of short films, is to be considered optional. Students who decide not to take advantage of this possibility will be evaluated on the basis of the program attended and will be evaluated as those who prefer to carry out the practical activities.
