

The Rome University of Fine Arts (RUFA) announces a public competition for the assignment of **2 collaboration grants (150 hours each)** in the **Guidance Office** – **Milan campus** for the academic year 2025/26.

Eligibility requirements: Applicants must be regularly enrolled in a first- or second-cycle degree course (excluding first-year students), be up to date with tuition and DSU fees, and have acquired a minimum number of ECTS credits (38 for second-year students, 64 for third-year students, 160 for graduating students enrolling in a second-cycle course, 38 for second-year second-cycle students). A minimum exam average of 26/30 is also required.

**Application procedure**: Applications must be submitted exclusively online via the form available at <a href="www.unirufa.it/servizi-e-facilities/borse-di-collaborazione">www.unirufa.it/servizi-e-facilities/borse-di-collaborazione</a> by **21 September 2025**. Supporting documents for additional qualifications must be sent to <a href="mailto:concorsi@unirufa.it">concorsi@unirufa.it</a>. Late applications will not be considered.

**Evaluation criteria**: Candidates are assessed by a Selection Committee through a points system up to a maximum of 30 points:

- exam average (up to 10 points),
- academic or professional qualifications (up to 5 points),
- oral interview, with preference given to previous experience in communication and promotion (up to 15 points).

**Selection outcome**: The 4 grants will be awarded to the candidates with the highest total scores. The final ranking list will be published on the official notice board and on the RUFA website.
