

Abstract – Call for Applications: 5 Student Collaboration Grants (Communication Office) – A.Y. 2025/26

RUFA – Rome University of Fine Arts announces a competition for **5 student collaboration grants** (150 hours each) within the **Communication and Events Office** for the Academic Year 2025/26.

Eligibility requirements:

Applicants must be regularly enrolled in first- or second-level academic courses (except first-year students) and up to date with tuition fees and the DSU regional tax. The call is open exclusively to students enrolled in the following programmes: *Graphic Design, Visual and Innovation Design, GD–Comic and Illustration, Multimedia Game Art, Photography and Audiovisual, Cinema, Film Arts, Computer Animation and Visual Effects.*

Students must have earned a minimum number of credits depending on their year of study (48–168 ECTS) and have achieved an average grade of at least **26/30**.

Technical requirements:

Applicants must own a **recent-generation smartphone**, a **camera**, and a **laptop**, and be proficient in the **Adobe Creative Suite** (Photoshop, Premiere, After Effects, Illustrator, etc.), as these tools are essential for performing the assigned tasks.

Language requirements:

During the oral interview, **international candidates must demonstrate Italian language proficiency at least at level B1 CEFR.**

Compensation:

The total remuneration amounts to **€1,095.00** (tax-exempt), corresponding to an hourly rate of **€7.30**. Payment will be made in two instalments after completion of 75 hours each, upon supervisor approval.

Main duties:

- Photo and video documentation of backstage activities and events;
- Creation of image and video content for social media (TikTok, Instagram) in line with RUFA's communication guidelines and tone of voice;
- Post-production of photos and videos using Adobe software;
- Development of posts and community engagement on Reddit to enhance the Academy's online reputation;
- Design of traditional and digital communication materials;

- Contribution to the ideation of new content formats for social media;
- Digital archiving and management of multimedia materials.

Creativity, reliability, punctuality, social media awareness, and teamwork are required.

Application procedure:

Applications must be submitted **exclusively online** through the form available at www.unirufa.it/servizi-e-facilities/borse-di-collaborazione no later than **27 October 2025**.

Evaluation and selection:

Each candidate is assessed up to a **maximum of 30 points**, distributed as follows:

- Academic average (up to 10 points);
- Additional qualifications (up to 5 points);
- Oral interview and portfolio presentation (up to 15 points).

In case of a tie, priority is given to students who were *eligible non-recipients* of DSU scholarships in the previous academic year.

Results and ranking:

Grants are awarded to the candidates with the highest scores. Rankings will be published on the official RUFA notice board and website.
