2. Better Social Spaces

At the Via Libetta campus, I want to make our daily spaces more inviting and comfortable:

Add more chairs and tables in the bar area.

- Install heaters so students can enjoy meals outside even in winter.
- Improve the relax room by adding more sofas and encouraging students to bring small board games or card games (everyone can contribute 1€ to help).
